# Merry Christmas from the Intervention Team

#### And that's a wrap!

What an incredible year (and for me personally, an incredible term and a half) at Irrawang Public School. Unprecedented is the word and whilst we were looking at Pandemic in our writing across the school this week, it struck me that for many students, especially younger students, did an incredible job, taking the craziness of 2021 in their stride. Our students have done so well and worked so hard to come back to school and keep putting one foot in front of the other to improve their learning.

We have had so many things happening in the Intervention Lab this year! We have run Literacy Programs: Friendly Phonemes for Kindergarten, Fantastic Phonemes for Stage 1, one on one reading support, in class reading support, in class writing support and our oral language program. To support the development of numeracy skills across the school we have run Numeracy Ninjas for Kindergarten, Numeracy Ninjas for Stage 1 and done work in class supporting the delivery of amazing lessons in Mathematics. We have run assessment, small group support, one to one support, in class support and through this have worked with every student in our school. That means that we have supported over 390 students across our school.

In recognition of all of this hard work, both by our teachers and our students, we are currently celebrating the enormous successes of 2020 (which was a pretty trying year). The personal growth of individual students is so exciting and as educators we could not be more proud! What better way to share success than to show pictures from our year in the Lab, in classrooms and across the school. From our incredible Intervention Team to you, have a wonderful Christmas and may 2021 be fresh beginnings and healthy and happy year for all!
