


Due to Stage 3 being away for our celebration day we didn't want them to miss out, so we will be celebrating a day earlier!

#### **Update from the Intervention Team**

It has been a busy term for our intervention team. Currently we are running Phonemic Awareness program in Kindergarten, Fantastic Phonemes for Stage 1, Kinder and Stage 1 Numeracy Ninjas to support development of the number strand in Mathematics, Stage 1 Writing Group support, Tier 3 reading intervention, in class support across all classes K-4 and online intervention in Stage 3 ... so many fantastic things have been happening to support our students.

Our highly skilled intervention team not only run incredible programs for students requiring additional support but manages whole school data collection and analysis to inform future directions for teaching and learning. So there is always a lot happening in our lab as well as in classrooms.

As Term 3 draws to a close it is now time to finalise some programs and run assessment while looking at our data to consider which programs will run next term, what they will look like and who will be involved. So another big week for our team.




